- a) All remittances should be crossed and made payable to the "Scottish Athletics ".
- b) Club Affiliation fees must have been paid to Scottish Athletics for Season 2013/14
- c) Competitors **must** wear their **club colours** in all events
- d) Unless entry forms are fully completed with all details required, entries will be rejected.
- e) In men's events competitors must be (a) Scots by birth or either of whose parents are Scots, or
- (b) must have resided in Scotland for at least three months prior to the race.

Students in Full-time Education in Scotland

Students in full-time education in Scotland may compete as First claim for both their educational establishment and another Scottish club but not in the same competition. This is provided that the educational establishment Club is confined to students of that establishment. Thus a student may be entered for two clubs but has to choose one at declaration.

Please ensure that any North District Cross Country Championship trophies won by your Club in November 2012 are returned by/on the day of these Championships.
